

Gracía's Story

For the Love of Grace was started in memory of Gracia (Gray-sha) Rae Maille. Gracia was born a happy healthy baby, but at 2 ½ months old she was hospitalized due to kidney failure and RSV (a respiratory virus). She was in the hospital for six weeks during which time she developed numerous other problems, but even with extensive testing there was no diagnosis for her illness.

Her mother spent every moment with her during the six weeks at the hospital, while her father tried to maintain the household and bills and care for Gracia's three siblings. The doctors and nurses determined that Gracia was stable enough to return home, but home was different than expected. Gracia had finished her fight here on

Earth and returned home to her Heavenly Father.

At only four months old, Gracia passed away...

This time in the hospital was a difficult one for the entire family. Currently, there is a lack of support for other families who

are experiencing similar situations and without a specific diagnosis, as funding is scarce. The founders of For the Love of Grace want to share Gracia's story by helping other families who have experienced the same difficult loss and economic hardship.

Why For the Love of Grace was Founded

At The Children's Hospital in Denver there are 270 beds. Of these beds there are 125 that have no funding sources available for families in need. That's nearly half! This is commonly due to the fact that a child has a disease that isn't well known or they have an undiagnosed illness. The founder discovered this after experiencing the hardship firsthand.
